I. BACKGROUND AND CONTENT OF CHANGE

This change adds Eugenics Asexualization and Sterilization Compensation to non-countable income for all benefits programs.

Revisions have been added to clarify previous published income policy related to Medicaid.

II. POLICY REVISIONS

A. Section 4030.2, Countable Unearned Income

Native American Gaming Proceeds

Native American Gaming per capita payments are counted only for the month in which the payment is received for Medicaid.

VA Aid and Attendance

Additional monthly pension benefits administered by the Department of Veterans Affairs that may be available to wartime Veterans and surviving spouses who have in-home care or who live in nursing homes or assisted-living facilities. SA, Medicaid or Subsidized Child Care: Do not count.

B. Section 4040, Non-Countable Income

Eugenics Asexualization and Sterilization Compensation

Eugenics Asexualization and Sterilization Compensation is added to Special Government Compensation. It is non-countable for all programs.

C. Section 4090.a, Budgeting New, Changed, or Terminated Income

.4a added to clarify budgeting new, changed, or terminated income for Medicaid.


D. Section 4080, Deductions, Exclusions, and Disregards

.20 Student Earned Income Exclusion (SEIE) is added for Family and Children's Medicaid.






